

Credit Rescue Days – Jan 28, 31 & Feb 1

As we near the end of Semester 1, here are some updates about Credit Rescue days.

Credit rescue is available for students who are at risk of not earning a credit.

Teachers will contact parents by email or phone for students who are at risk of not earning the credit in a course. **Students will be invited by their subject teacher to attend credit rescue opportunities and work on completing any outstanding or missing work.**

Credit Rescue days are scheduled for:

Monday Jan 31 (Week 2)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All students log in virtually for attendance only, and review asynchronous activities @ 10:00 a.m. and 12:45 p.m.• Students invited for credit rescue by teacher attend classes virtually or in-person, as arranged with the teacher
Tuesday Feb 1 (Week 2)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All students log in virtually for attendance only, and review asynchronous activities @ 10:00 a.m. and 12:45 p.m.• Students invited for credit rescue by teacher attend by appointment virtually
Wednesday Feb 2 (PA DAY)	<u>NO SCHOOL</u>
Thursday Feb 3	First day of Semester 2 – following a regular four-period day.

Please note:

- Participating in credit rescue provides the chance for a student to improve a failing mark and access teacher support.
- Participation does not guarantee a student will pass the course, but it does give the opportunity for many students to improve a failing mark to a passing mark, or to a mark that may open the possibility of credit recovery or Summer School.

These three Credit Rescue days are still attendance-taking days for ALL students. Students who are not invited in for Credit Rescue on these days are expected to log in virtually to their Week 1 classes at 10:00 a.m. and 12:45 p.m. on Friday January 28th, and to their Week 2 classes at 10:00 a.m. and 12:45 p.m. on Monday January 31st and Tuesday February 1st for attendance and to access asynchronous activities.
